



### **Class 123 Battle of the Breeds Saddle Seat Pleasure Jackpot**

**Gait Requirements:** To be shown at a walk, trot and canter both ways of the ring. Horses must stand quietly in the line up. Horses may or may not stretch in the line up. Horses will NOT be asked to back.

**Appointments:** A full bridle, pelham or curb, English type saddle (no forward seat or dressage saddle allowed). Horses must be shown with a full mane and tail without braids or ornamentation of any kind. Tails may not be tied. A single snaffle, hackamore, martingale or tie down are prohibited. **Rider:** Informal saddle seat attire with coat and hat or protective headgear.

**Judging:** To be judged on manners, performance, presence, quality and conformation.

### **Class 89 Battle of the Breeds Hunter Pleasure Jackpot**

#### **Pleasure Specs apply**

**Gait Requirements:** To be shown at a walk, trot and canter both ways of the ring. Entries may be asked to hand gallop one or more directions of the ring at the judges discretion. Horses must stand quietly in the line up. Horses must not stretch in the line up. **Horses will NOT be asked to back.** **Horses will NOT be asked to halt.**

**Appointments:** Forward, balanced seat or side saddle, snaffle bridle, pelham with two reins, kimberwicke bits or a full bridle (curb and snaffle). If a full bridle is used, it must be of hunter style and excessive length of the curb shank shall be penalized. Breast plates are permissible but martingales are prohibited. Horses may be shown with or without braided manes &/or tails. **Rider:** Traditional hunter style jacket, breeches or hunter jodhpurs, dark hunting cap, derby or protective headgear and appropriate boots. Tall dress or tall field boots are preferred as traditional. A stock, choker or four in hand with any color shirt is correct. Shadbellies are prohibited.

**Judging:** Judged on manners, performance, presence, quality and conformation.
