OIHS RULES AND REGULATIONS

1. USEF Membership Statement:

Life, senior active and junior active members shall be eligible to participate in all classes at Regular Competitions, Eventing Competitions at the Modified Level or above and Combined Driving Competitions at the Advanced Level, Dressage, Reining and Vaulting Competitions and Endurance Rides. A non-member may participate as a handler, rider, driver, owner, lessee, or agent Competitions, Regular Eventing Competitions, Dressage Competitions, Reining Competitions and Combined Driving Competitions upon payment of a Show Pass fee. Participants in the following classes are exempted from the Requirements of this rule: 1) leadline; 2) exhibitions; 3) games and races; 4) classes for 4-H members; 5) walk trot and academy classes (academy classes are classes limited to horses used regularly in a lesson program); 6) USDF introductory level tests, pas de deux and quadrille classes; 7) assistant handlers in Dressage Sport Horse Breeding classes.

2. USEF Fees:

Every horse in this competition shall pay a \$15.00 fee for Drugs and Medication and an \$8.00 fee for USEF.

3. USEF Rules:

EVERY CLASS OFFERED HEREIN WHICH IS COVERED BY THE RULES AND SPECIFICATIONS OF THE CURRENT USEF RULE BOOK WILL BE CONDUCTED AND JUDGED IN ACCORDANCE THERE WITH.

4. Safe Sport Requirements:

All USEF Life and Senior Active members, as well as participants who have regular contact with minor athletes, are required to comply with the U.S. Center for SafeSport training requirement to be eligible to participate in the competition.

5. Arenas:

All arenas have custom blended, all weather, GGT Footing. Arena measurements—WEC Grand Arena: 320' x 400; Indoor 1 171' x 530', Indoor 4: 192' x 525' and Hunter 3 & 4 175' x 300'.

6. Show Office:

The Show Office will be open on Friday, October 17 at 9:00am. Office Hours will be posted on the office door.

7. Arrival Time:

Stalls will be available Friday, October 17 at 10:00am. For early arrivals please contact Kent Moeller 804 363 3085. All stalls have doors and are permanent concrete stalls with stable comfort mattress systems and fans in a climate controlled barn. 12' x 12' and 12' x 14'. Stalls may not be occupied by more than one horse at a time. Damage: Exhibitors will be financially responsible for any damage to their stalls on the premises. Do not put nails in the sidewalls. Stalls must be vacated in their original condition. Stalls may not be structurally altered in any way. All damages that WEC charges Ocala International Horse Show will be billed back to the trainer. This charge will automatically

be added to your final invoice through the horse show office. Charges from WEC billed to the Ocala International Horse Show for removal of lumber or other items used for decorating purposes will be billed to the trainer following the show.

8. Registration/Membership Requirements:

Copies of Registration papers showing proof of ownership, along with all required membership cards should be submitted when the entries are submitted. If that is not possible, copies must be presented to the show office upon check in.

9. Entries:

Entries must be postmarked, completed on line or emailed by October 8, 2025. Entries postmarked after that date will be charged an additional \$50.00 per horse post entry fee. Entries must be accompanied by full payment in order to be processed. Open checks mailed in with entries are acceptable. Entries must be properly made on the official entry form.

11. Refunds:

All fees (except Office Fees) canceled before the October 15 deadline will be refunded. Refunds for class entry fees only will be made after that date upon presentation to the Show Secretary (delivered or emailed) a signed and dated Veterinarian's Certificate on letterhead. All refunds will be mailed within 30 days following the show.

12. Returned checks/Declined Credit Cards:

A \$100.00 fee will be assessed to each non-negotiable check received by the show. A \$50.00 fee will be assessed for each declined credit card. It is the responsibility of the trainer to provide valid credit cards when making the entries. If management must avail itself of the remedies available under the USEF Rules an additional \$100.00 penalty will be assessed for a total of \$200.00 / \$150.00 (maximum). During the show an open check or credit card must be on file in the show office for any additions/ changes made during the show. Accounts will be closed out following the show and receipts emailed to the trainer.

13. Health Requirements:

Florida regulations require that all equines be covered by official interstate health certificates, issued by a licensed veterinarian, showing that the animals are free from any symptoms of any infectious or communicable disease. The certificate shall include the name of the owner and address,

destination in Florida, number of horses examined, the name, registration number(s), if any, tattoo, if any, sex, age, rectal temperature, color and markings of each animal listed. Health certificates will become void after 30 days from issue. Health certificates must show animals to be negative to an equine infectious anemia test within the past 12 months. Date of the test and the approved laboratory must be shown on the health certificate. Horses entering the grounds must be accompanied by documentation of Equine Influenza Virus and Equine Herpes Virus (Rhinopneumonitis) vaccinations within 6 months prior to entering the stables. Horses not in compliance with this rule may be required to leave the competition grounds upon request by Competition Management. Documentation should consist of one of the following methods mentioned below. The frequency of the vaccine administration should be per the vaccine manufacturer's or veterinarian's recommendations. It is recommended that vaccines are administered by a veterinarian. 2) In the case of vaccines administered by a veterinarian, the exhibitor, upon request by Competition Management, must provide documentation from the veterinarian on documenting that the horse in question received the vaccinations: name of the vaccines and date of vaccine administration. 3) In the case of vaccines administered by a person other than a veterinarian, the exhibitor upon request by

Competition Management, must provide a receipt of the vaccine purchase which is signed by the owner or agent with care, custody, and control of the horse; name, serial number and expiration date of the vaccine; and date of vaccine administration. 4) In the case of a horse that is unable to receive either of the vaccinations due to a history of adverse reactions, the exhibitor, upon request from Competition Management, must provide a letter from the veterinarian on official letterhead stating that the horse in question cannot be vaccinated due to medical concerns and a log of temperatures taken twice daily for the seven days prior to entering the competition grounds. These horses must also have their temperatures taken and logged twice daily while on the competition grounds. The log of temperatures should be provided to the Competition Management, steward or technical delegate when requested. 5) Competition Management may not amend or enhance vaccination requirements without prior approval of the Veterinary Committee.

14. Officials:

In the event that, due to illness or failure of a show official to attend this show or perform his duties, the Show Committee reserves the right to substitute a Show Official. No one shall approach or contact a Judge with regard to a decision unless they first obtain permission from the Show Steward who may arrange an appointment with the Judge at a proper time and place.

Health Certificates and Coggins are required of all horses entering the show grounds.

All health certificates must be within 30 days of the arrival date.

15. Judging System:

The Majority Opinion System will be used to tabulate all classes.

16. Junior Exhibitors:

The age for Junior Exhibitors will be based on their age as of December 1, 2024.

17. Campers, RV Slips, Golf Carts:

18. Dogs/Animals Leash Requirements:

Dogs must be kept on a leash at all times while on the property. Any dog that is deemed aggressive by WEC Staff or security will be asked to be removed from the property or put away in the owner's residence. No dogs are allowed in working arenas (Arena 4 and Hotel Grand Show Arena) at any time during the week of OIHS. WEC Security will pick up unleashed dogs.

19. Motorized Vehicle Statement:

Minors who do not have a valid driver's license which allows them to operate a motorized vehicle in the state in which they reside will not be permitted to operate a motorized vehicle of any kind, including, but not limited to, golf carts, motorcycles, scooters, or farm utility vehicles on the

competition arounds of licensed competitions. Minors who have a valid temporary license may operate the above described motorized vehicles as long as they are accompanied by an adult with a valid driver's license. The parent/legal guardian or individual who signs the entry blank as a parent or guardian of a minor operating a motorized vehicle in violation of this rule are solely responsible for any damages, claims, losses or actions resulting from that operation. Violations of this rule will be cause for penalties against those responsible for the child committing the offense. Wheelchairs and other mobility assistance devices for individuals with disabilities are exempt from this rule. The unsafe use of personal electronic transport devices, as determined by the competition officials and management in their sole discretion, that do not require a driver's license to operate, including but not limited to, segways, hoverboards. and single wheeled scooters is prohibited on competition grounds. Operating such devices in areas where people gather may be deemed "unsafe use" if there is a risk of harm to others. If the operator of the device is a minor, the parent/legal guardian or individual who signs the entry blank as a parent or quardian of a minor operating the device in violation of this rule is accountable and may be subject to penalties. Wheelchairs and other mobility assistance devices for individuals with disabilities are exempt from this rule.

20. PA System:

Due to unforeseen problems with any mechanical device, the PA System and class calls over that system are considered a courtesy. The exhibitor is responsible to have his horse at the gate at the prescribed time. While every effort will be made to maintain a working PA System, no refund will be made, section changed, or protest upheld on the basis of a PA failure.

21. Sharps Containers:

Sharps Containers (USEF GR 1210. 4) Competition Management shall place a minimum of one sharps container per each competition, whether or not stabling is provided. Additionally, at least one sharps container per fifty occupied stalls for disposal of needles and other disposable sharp instruments in convenient locations in barns housing competition horses.

UPHA CHAPTER 16 ACADEMY RULES AND REGULATIONS

The Academy division is for those riders and/or drivers who have never shown in an "A" circuit show. Helmets are required for ALL riders in compliance with the 2009 congressional helmet law.

AGE & DIVISION

Membership to the Florida State High Point Program is required for all riders wanting to compete in the Academy classes. A rider's age for the competition year is determined on December 1st the preceding year.

CLASS RULES

Headers are allowed in if needed for safety, no towels or whips allowed in with them. Classes will be split at the 13th rider. Splits will be shuffled to keep equitation and showmanship back to back (i.e.: 1a, 2a, 1b, 2b). Class holds will be 2 minutes in length. NO EXCEPTIONS. Holds must be requested 15 minutes before the academy session/show begins. Gate times will be strictly enforced and as one class exits the next will promptly be called. Horses will individually enter and exit the arena for each class, unless an exception granted by UPHA President or Vice-President.

ACADEMY HORSES

Horses in academy classes MUST be a lesson horse regularly used in a professionally operated lesson program. The horses must display safety characteristics accordingly. Horses will be excused from the competition for unsafe behavior such as going too fast for a rider to handle. Horses are not to be judged, and must be serviceably sound. No farm/barn affiliation should be visible on the horse, tack, or rider.

TURN OUT

Required is a plain shod horse, 1 therapeutic pad and or wedge allowed. No saddle seat mane braids or artificial appliances are to be used. Hoof blacking and hunter braiding is optional. Any protective leg wraps, knee boots, bell boots, splint boots are allowed, but must be similar color to the horse's body color (i.e., no white wraps allowed unless the horse's body is white).

ACADEMY EQUITATION

Judged on the rider's basic equitation skills with correct diagonals and leads, proper use of ring is considered.

ACADEMY SHOWMANSHIP

Judged on the rider's horsemanship abilities. It is judged on the rider's ability to control and show his/her horse. The rider's command of the horse, for example, speed, collectiveness, and placement in the ring is to be considered. Walk-trot riders should not be penalized for incorrect diagonals. For walk-trot-canter riders, promptness in finding the correct leads and diagonals is important.

WALK/TROT ON THE LINE CLASS

Riders are to be judged on form and presentation style. Walk-Trot riders will enter the ring at a walk, be judged on the rail as a group at the walk both directions of the ring. The class will line up. Each rider and leader will individually trot down one long rail, reverse and trot back, and return to the line-up. Trainers may designate a temporary header in the line-up should he/she need to run with another of the riders. In equitation classes diagonals will count, trainers may help with diagonals. In showmanship class, diagonals will not count. If a show only has one Walk/Trot lead line class on the schedule, it is to be conducted as an equitation class.

NOVICE CLASSES

For each age division and for riders who have not received 3 blue ribbons in any and all academy divisions (except Lead Line classes).

CONTINUED UPHA CHAPTER 16 ACADEMY RULES AND REGULATIONS

TACK AND APPOINTMENTS

SADDLE SEAT

Tack: Horses may be shown in a snaffle bridle with a running martingale or German martingale, Pelham, or double bridle, no draw reins allowed. Saddles must be a cutback English saddle. No tie downs, side/over checks, standing martingales, or blinkers are allowed.

Attire: Jodhpurs, jodhpur boots or paddocks boots, long sleeve button-down or collared shirts, tie and gloves are required. Vests are optional, no derbies allowed. Riding whip and non-roweled spurs are optional. Long hair must be secured back in a bun or braid(s).

HUNT SEAT

Tack: Horses may be shown in a snaffle bridle with or without a running martingale or German martingale, Pelham or double bridles are allowed, no draw reins are allowed. Saddles must be hunt seat saddles. No tie downs or blinkers are allowed, standing martingales for over fences classes are permitted.

Attire: Breeches, an appropriate hunt seat shirt, hunt boots, paddock boots, or black half chaps with black paddock boots and gloves are required. Riding crop and non-roweled spurs are optional. Long hair must be secured back in a bun or braid(s).

WESTERN

Tack: Horses may be shown in a snaffle bridle with or without a running martingale with two hands or a single curb bit bridle with one hand. Saddles must be western saddles. No ties downs, standing martingales, or blinkers are allowed.

Attire: Jeans or pants, a western style shirt, jodhpur, paddock or western boots and gloves are required. Chaps and Western hats are not allowed. "Polo" shirts are not allowed. Whips and non-roweled spurs are optional. Long hair must be secured back in a bun or braid(s).

DRIVING

Tack: Any 2 wheeled vehicle is allowed. Any work or show harness and cart may be used as long as it is in good working condition. **Attire:** Any academy attire is appropriate or you may wear pleasure driving attire. Glasses or goggles and gloves are required. Driving whip is optional. Instructor may ride along with the driver; however, no instruction can be given.

ELIGIBILITY TO COMPETE IN THE ACADEMY PROGRAM

Riders and drivers who have competed in any "show riders," USEF, Star Rated, A-Circuit type classes at any show in any discipline are ineligible to compete in the Academy program and must register FSHPP Performance Division program (exception: "A-circuit" level riders may compete in Academy driving classes, also "A-circuit" level drivers may compete in Academy riding classes).

Academy riders/drivers may participate in any open breed schooling shows and still be eligible to compete in UPHA Chapter 16 Academy classes and earn FSHPP points as long as these guidelines are followed:

- 1. If you compete in Academy W/T, you can not canter at any other shows.
- 2. If you compete at a schooling show in dressage, you must only compete in Intro level tests, and not in a jacket. Above Intro level, you are considered an "A-Circuit" rider, even if it is at a schooling show.
- 3. If you compete at a schooling show in hunter/jumper classes they must be considered "short" stirrup or "long" stirrup classes.
- 4. You must submit a copy of the prize list of the schooling show to FSHPP within 14 days of the competition, with the Show Secretary's contact information for verification of the results.

For and in consideration of United States Equestrian Federation, Inc. dba US Equestrian ("USEF") allowing me, the undersigned, to participate in any capacity (including as a rider, driver, handler, vaulter, longeur, lessee, owner, agent, coach, official, trainer or volunteer) in a USEF sanctioned, licensed or approved event or activity, including but not limited to equestrian clinics, practices, shows, competitions and related or incidental activities and ("USEF Event" or "USEF Events"); I, for myself, and on behalf of my spouse, children, heirs and next of kin, and any legal and personal representatives, executors, administrators, successors, and assigns, hereby agree to and make the following contractual representations pursuant to this Agreement (the "Agreement"):

A. RULES AND REGULATIONS: I hereby agree that I have read, understand, and agree to be bound by all applicable Federation Bylaws, rules, and policies including the USEF Safe Sport Policy and Minor Athlete Abuse Prevention Policies (MAAPP) as published at www.usef.org, as amended from time to time.

B. Below are the instructions to enter online

WHAT YOU NEED

A free account at Horse Shows Online. If you don't already have an account you can create one at www.horse-showsonline.com. Horse Shows Online basic membership is free. A record in your account for each person and horse that you will use on show entry forms when you enter a show. Records will be saved and can be used for future shows.

HOW DO I GET STARTED

- Login to Horse Shows Online at www.horseshowsonline.com, click on the member services button on the main menu.
- Once you are logged in click the "My Horses, People, Shows" button in the member menu.
- At the People, Horses, Shows page, add any new people and horses to your account as required on the appropriate tab (ie: My People, My Horses).
- NOTE that people and horses are saved with your account. Once you have those records in your account you
 can use them at every show you enter.
- Click the "Enter Show" button to select the show you want to enter and follow the steps in the outline entry
 wizard.

STEPS TO ENTER A SHOW

- Select the show you want to enter from your "My People, Horses, Shows" page on the My Show Entries tab,
 or find the show you want to enter in the show selector and click the Online Entry Icon.
- NOTE this will start the online entry wizard. Make sure you have already created the horses and people in
 your member account. The online entry wizard will guide you through the steps to complete the entry form.
- The basic steps in the wizard are:
 - Select the horses, people and riders for your entry
 - Select the classes each rider is entered in
 - Select the quantity for stalls and other fees
 - · Confirm your selections
- Checkout and submit the show entry
- The final steps generates the completed entry form and submits your entry to the show for review and
 acceptance. If the show requires a payment at entry time you will be prompted for your credit card information.

TIPS

- 1. You can cancel the entry part way through the wizard and resume the entry later on. **For example**, if you need to add more people to your account, or just want to come back and complete the entry later.
- 2. Unfinished entry forms are listed in your "My entries" tab and will allow you to edit the entry.
- People and horses you create in your account are saved permanently and can be used in other shows you enter. You only need to add people and horses once and then they can be re-used.


